GPS vs. Smart Phone

- ⦿ GPS satellites cover the entire globe
- ⦿ Cell towers cover high population areas

- ⦿ GPS does one thing well
- ⦿ Smart phones do many things average

- ⦿ GPS is ruggedized, phones are not

Snowmobiling with a GPS

- ⦿ Automotive GPS can be used
 - Protect it from the weather
 - Conserve battery power
 - A cigarette lighter plug can be used
- ⦿ Ruggedized GPS mounted to dash
 - Hardwire to battery
 - A cigarette lighter plug can be used

GPS Map Features

- The map is part of your dashboard
- Your location moves on the map
- Leaves a breadcrumb trail
- Viewed easily at night
- Hundreds of gas, food & lodging POIs
- Zoom in to 50 feet or out to 50 miles
- Better estimate of arrival time
- Combines multiple paper maps into one

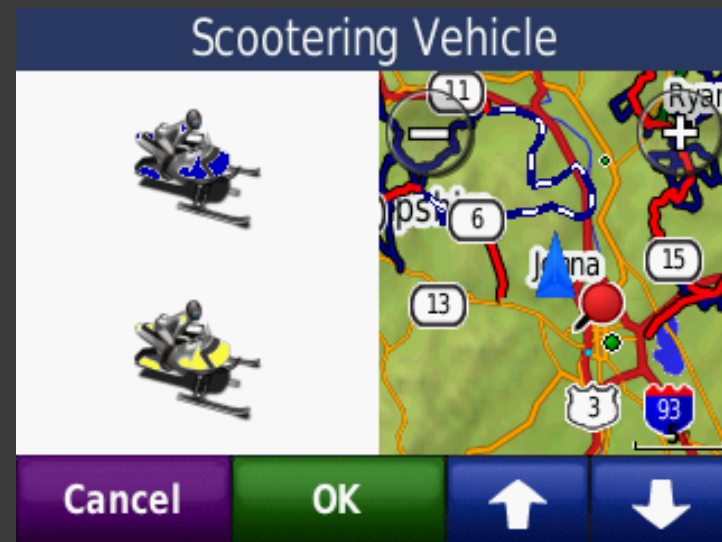

GPS Settings - Vehicle

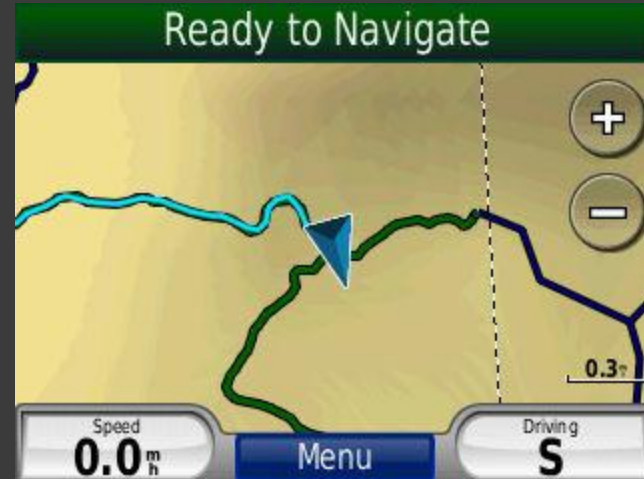
- Set your vehicle (icon)
 - Use something that shows direction of travel
 - Custom icons available at Garmin Garage



GPS Settings – Map View

☉ “North Up”

- Travel direction
 - North - Icon moves up
 - South - Icon moves down
 - East - Icon moves right
 - West - Icon moves left



☉ “Track Up”

- Travel direction
 - Icon always moves up
 - Map rotates with direction

☉ “3D”

- Behaves like Track Up



GPS Settings – Trip Log

- Set the Trip Log to “Show”
- Shows a “bread crumb” trail of where you have been
- Can be used to “TracBack”



A Day On The Trail

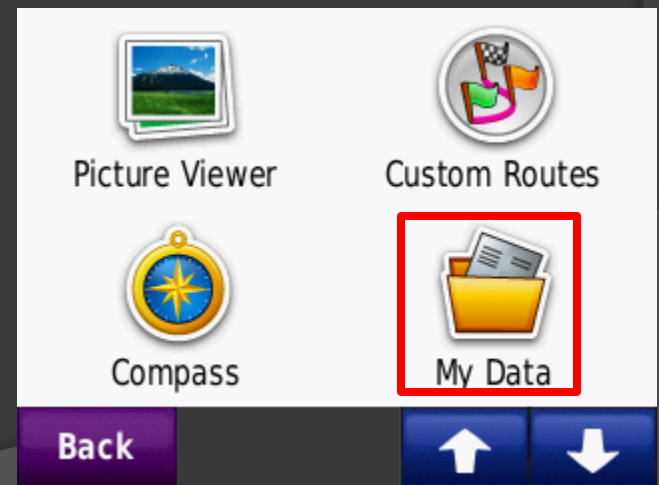
Reset the Trip Statistics

- Not so obvious
- Press “Speed” indicator on map display



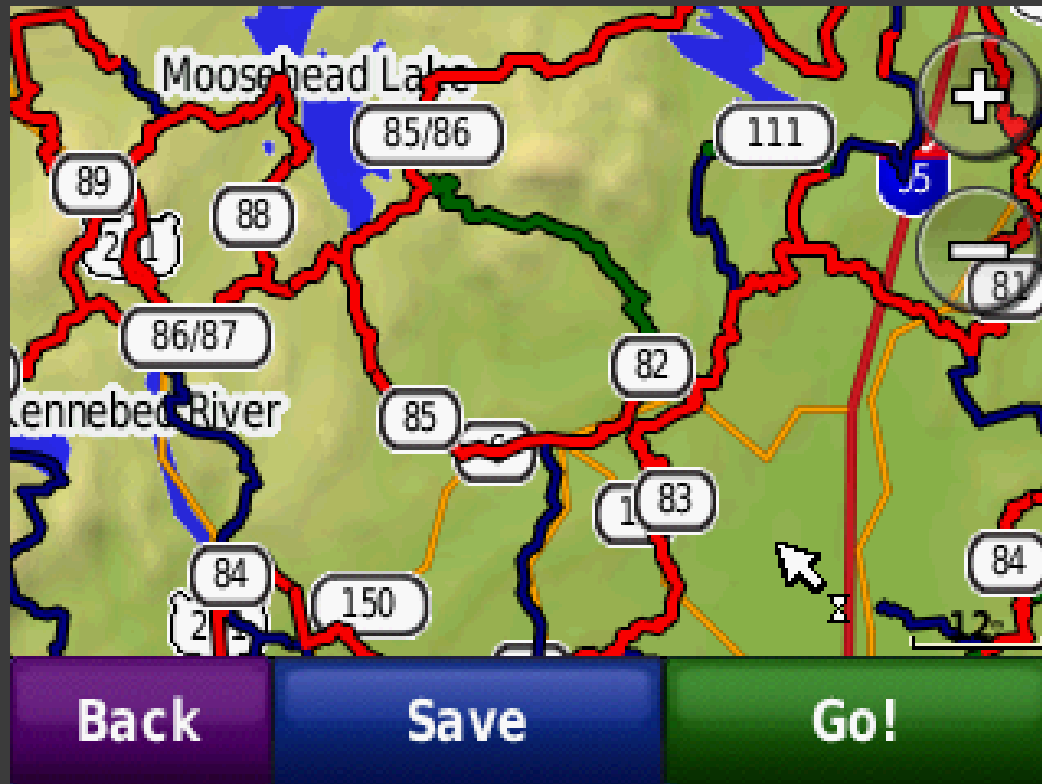
Clear Trip Log

- Press “Tools”
- Press “My Data”



A Day On The Trail

- Zoom out to about half your riding plan.



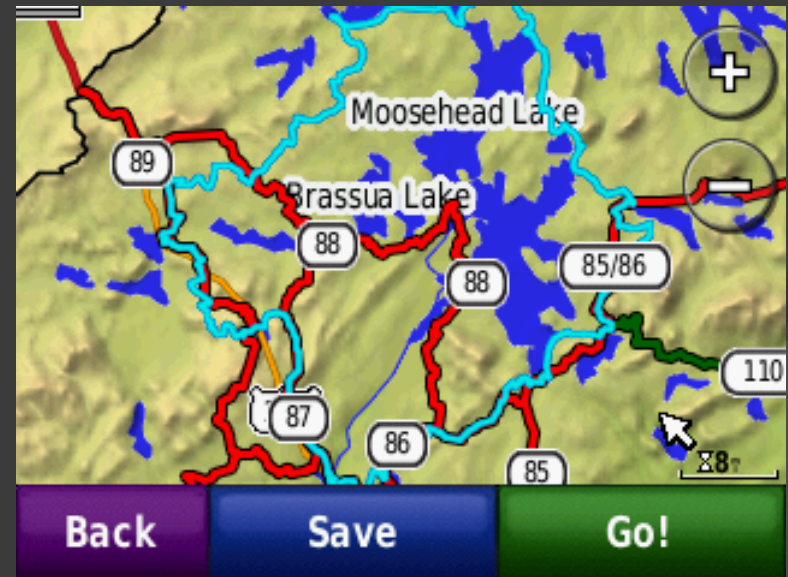
A Day On The Trail

- Zoom in at trail intersections to see what options are on the map.



A Day On the Trail

- Monitor your location, distance traveled and time.
 - TracBack will always be available.



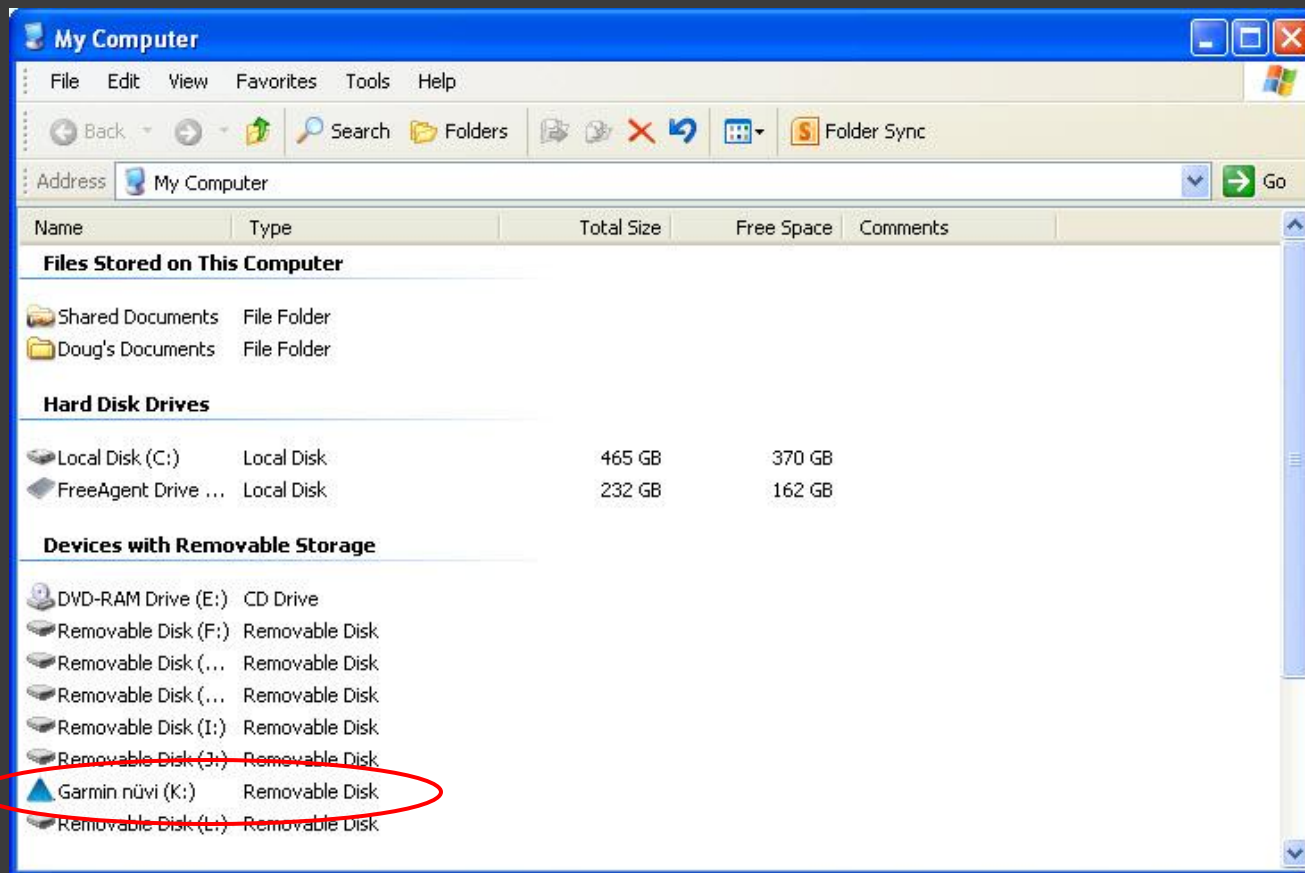
Capture Your Trip Log

- Use a USB cable to connect your GPS to the computer.



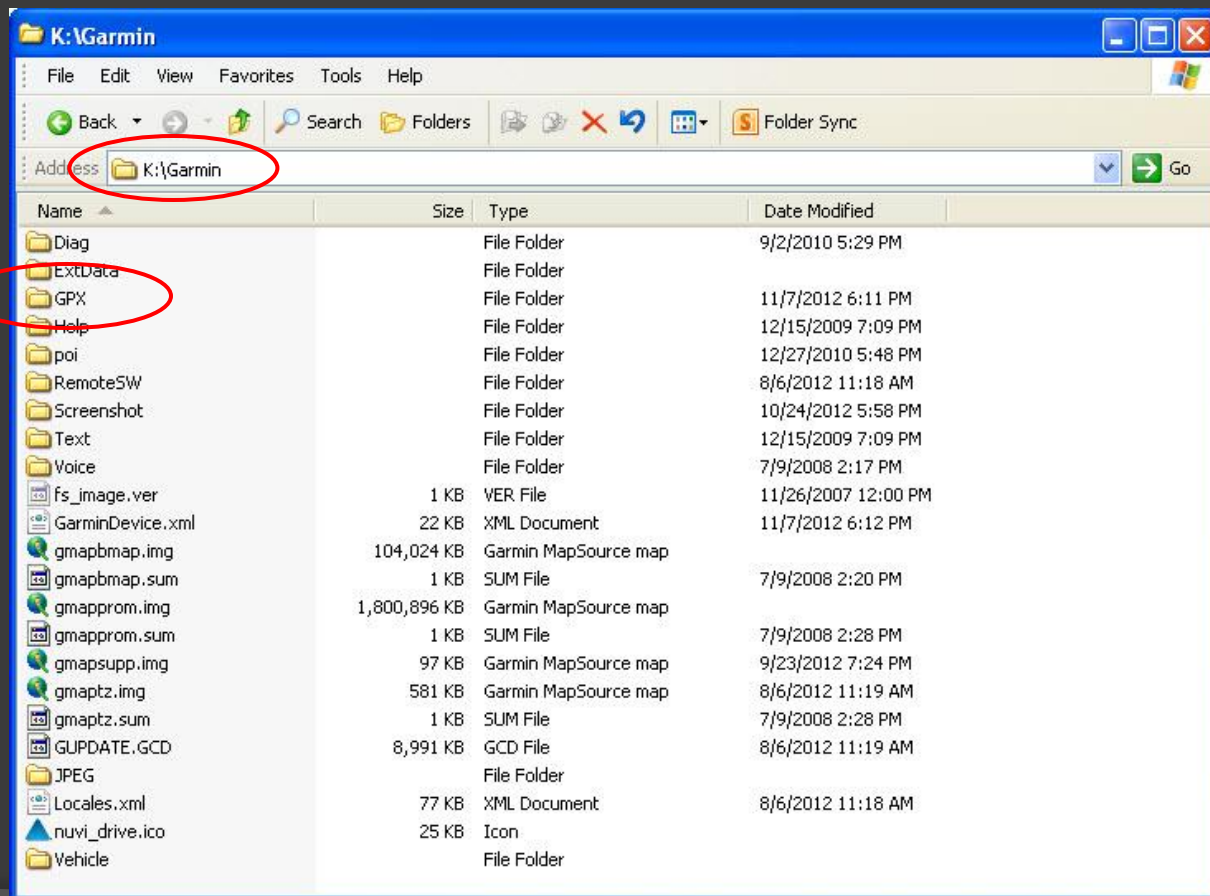
Capture Your Trip Log

- Find your GPS listed in My Computer.



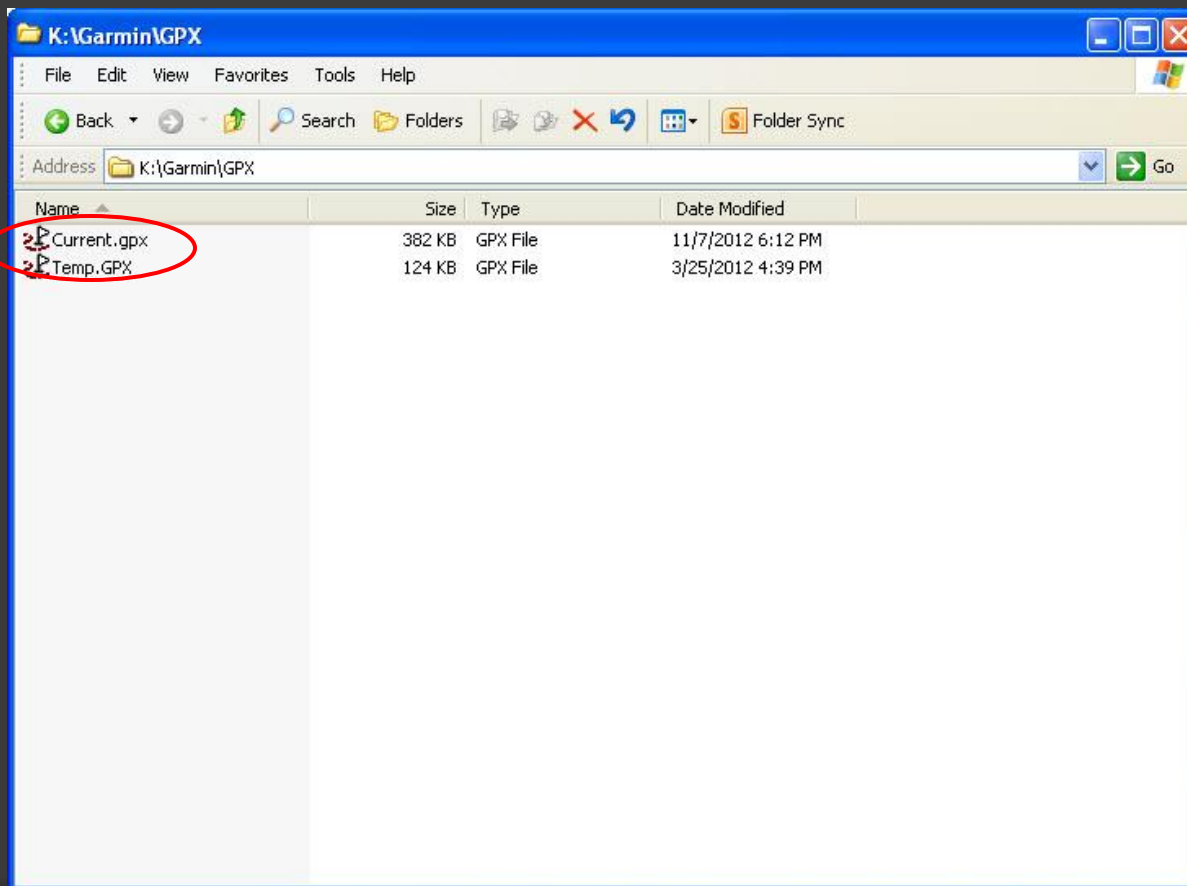
Capture Your Trip Log

- Usually there is a \Garmin\GPX folder.



Capture Your Trip Log

- The Trip Log is the current.gpx file.



Send Your Trip Log In

- ⦿ Copy the .gpx file to your computer
 - Don't delete from GPS (no harm if you do)
- ⦿ Attach the .gpx file to an e-mail
- ⦿ Send your trip log even if there are no new trails, to keep the data “fresh”

- ◉ DESIGN - Digital graphic design for print
- ◉ WEBSITE - Map images for your website
- ◉ PRINT – Map printing and folding
- ◉ GPS TRAINING – Instructions on how to use a GPS
- ◉ GPS MAPPING – GPS recording of your trail system
